In accordance with the Onondaga County Citizen Participation Plan developed under requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, Onondaga County hereby announces that the 2017 Action Plan is available for review and comment by all interested parties. MULROY CIVIC CENTER, 11<sup>TH</sup> FLOOR CONFERENCE ROOM** to review and prepare for the submission of the 2017 Action Plan. The final 2017 Grant allocations have not yet been released by the US Dept of Housing & Urban Development, but based on the 2016 grants, the approximate amount of funding available for the program year beginning September 1, 2017 is as follows:

Sixteen (16) capital projects and three (3) contingent projects have been proposed in cooperation with the towns and villages of Onondaga County and the Community Development Steering Committee and are included in the One Year Action Plan.

Housing activities include: 1) housing rehabilitation assistance with lead hazard reduction, handicapped accessibility, home repairs for the elderly, and emergency repairs; and 2) homeownership assistance. Housing rehabilitation is available to qualified low income families living in Onondaga County.

The 2017 Action Plan includes a \$750,000 float loan to further homeownership activities in Onondaga County.

As measured by the standards set forth in the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development regulations governing the Community Development Block Grant Program, approximately **98%** percent of the program year funds will be used for activities benefiting low and moderate income persons.
